A tax rate of \$0.037591 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Duval County Groundwater Conservation District.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2021 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Duval County Groundwater Conservation District from the same properties in both the 2020 tax year and the 2021 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Duval County Groundwater Conservation District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Duval County Groundwater Conservation District is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2021 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 25, 2021 AT 600 pm AT 231 E Railroad Ave, Benavides, Texas.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Duval County Groundwater Conservation District is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Duval County Groundwater Conservation District at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.
